Helicopter Safety

All rules apply whether the helicopter is running or static

- 1. Slow Down working around a helicopter! Use extreme caution. Never be in a hurry.**
- 2. If you are not directly involved in the helicopter portion of the shoot please stay at least 100 feet away at all times.**
- 3. If you need to go near the helicopter, permission must be obtained from either the aerial coordinator or the involved pilot.**
- 4. Always approach the helicopter from the front in a crouched manner. Avoid the tail rotor (rear area) at all times.**
- 5. No hats are allowed to be worn on set when the helicopter is operating.**
- 6. When carrying equipment towards the helicopter do so in a horizontal manner.**
- 7. Never throw anything towards or away from the helicopter.**
- 8. When the helicopter is either taking off or landing, all loose equipment must be secured.**
- 9. No Smoking within 100 feet from the helicopter**
- 10. If you see something unsafe that could be a potential hazard do not be afraid to report it immediately to the aerial coordinator or involved pilot.**

When the helicopter is operating **KEEP YOUR HEAD UP!**
STAY ALERT AT ALL TIMES!
